3 Months Certificate Course in

***“CRISIS INTERVENTION AND SOCIAL WORK PRACTICE IN
TRAUMA CARE”***

(6th Batch: April 2023 – June 2023)

OVERVIEW:

- This is a three-month Certificate Course on ‘**Crisis Intervention and Social Work Practice in Trauma Care**’ for postgraduate students in social work. The course is proposed to address the training needs in the area of Emergency and Trauma Care, NIMHANS.
- **Course Highlights:** This course will prepare the candidates with the essential knowledge and enhancing skills to identify, assess and provide psychosocial first aid during crisis situation and traumatic events.
- The course will impart case-based learning, didactic interactive sessions, direct supervision from faculty of various departments related to trauma and its management. In addition, observational and hands-on training will enable effectively to identify mental health well-being and promotion for the caregivers and family members.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO APPLY FOR THE COURSE:

- The course is open to those who have obtained a Master’s Degree in Social Work (full time), from a university recognized by UGC, securing not less than 55% marks in the aggregate of the Master’s Degree as a whole. Direct candidates, those deputed from other organizations, and sponsored candidates from State/Central Government /Armed forces/Other NGOs can be admitted to the course through proper channels.

HOW TO APPLY?

Selection will be done based on eligibility criteria. The interested candidates should send their application via email or hard copy on plain paper along with the following documents:

- i. One-page writes upon the reason to pursue the certificate course
- ii. Bio data with a recent passport-size photograph, full postal address, Email ID and phone number.
- iii. Research and work experience-related documents, if any

1. Introduction to Social Work Theories and Models in Emergency and Trauma Care
2. Understanding brain and spine
3. Components of traumatic life events
4. Impact of trauma on health and mental health well-being
5. Understanding grief and bereavement and PTSD.
6. Micro skills, basic interviewing and counselling skills
7. Crisis Assessment and Crisis Intervention
8. Clinical and Practical exposure

CRITERIA FOR COURSE COMPLETION:

- Case series presentation based on clinical exposure
- Development of IEC materials (pamphlets, booklets, audio-visual aid, applications)
- Group activities related to trauma care
- Home/organizational/observation visit/case management

KEY RESOURCE PERSONS:

- Various Field experts NIMHANS and from other institutions.

- Duration: Three Months full-time, on-campus @ NIMHANS.
- Course dates: 1st of April 2023 –30th of June 2023.
- Number of Seats: Maximum 6 per intake in every batch.
